1. PROLOGUE:

The position of Honorary National Research Officer (NRO) was created upon the recommendations from the National Committee (1998) (ref.: Motion 1) in fulfillment of the AHWCA Constitution paragraph 2.5 which states that the AHWCA has, as one of its purposes, "...to conduct and encourage research in areas relating to chaplaincy". The NRO position was ratified by the AHCWA AGM in Brisbane 1999. The AHWCA National Executive upgraded the title to National 'Research Fellow' in November 2007 given the organizational demands of the role and to encourage succession and establishment of State Research Officers within each chapter of the AHWCA.

2. NRF RESEARCH & PUBLICATIONS UNDERTAKEN 2007:

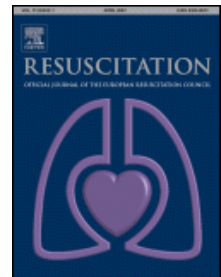
This year my progress in conducting research and publishing chaplaincy / pastoral care articles has been hampered – not because of IT / computer problems (like last year) but because my lecturing and research commitments at La Trobe university have increased. Further, while I am still negotiating with publishers about releasing a book on chaplaincy research, I have, nevertheless, been able to progress several articles from 'in-press' status to 'full-publication' as well as develop some new journal material.

Also I am glad to acknowledge that, first, Rev. Dr. Christopher Newell, has accepted the role of State Research Officer (AHWCA Tasmania) making him our very first state research officer appointment (congratulations Tasmania and Christopher); secondly Rabbi Dr. Jeffrey Cohen has been assisting both Christopher and myself with writing and reviewing research for publication. Both chaplains have been an added bonus to chaplaincy and pastoral care research. Another highlight was attending the NCCH ICD Conference in Sydney (2007) and the possibility of more of our material being published in the UK and US. 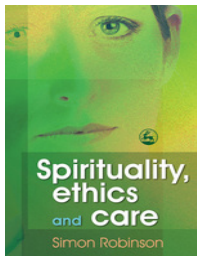
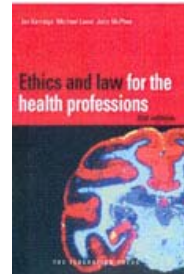

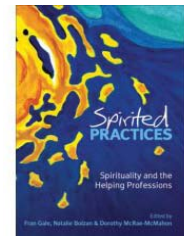
